State law requires that cities certify their proposed property tax levies to the county auditor by September 30th. Once certified, the proposed tax levy can be reduced but cannot be increased. The EDA bylaws require the EDA to submit a budget annually to the City Council for consideration and incorporation into the City's annual budget and tax levy.
